

### TASTE

The beauty of Wire Works' unique botanical blend meets the complexity of American oak in this intriguing spirit. The first sip introduces floral and spicy notes, which evolve to vanilla sweetness on the pallet before finishing with soft caramel and oak. The truly elegant nature of this aged gin offers a flavor experience like no other. Special Reserve Wire Works can be enjoyed in both conventional gin and whiskey cocktails or savored with a few cubes of ice.

### BACKGROUND

Wire Works Special Reserve bridges the gap between the brown caramel sweetness of a whiskey and the bright citrus nature of our signature gin.

### PROCESS

To make Special Reserve, we start with Wire Works' nine botanicals and blend them to stand up to the mellowing nature of oak. The spirit is then aged in used American bourbon barrels which imparts flavors traditionally reserved for whiskeys and rums.

### WHAT'S IN THE BOTTLE

#### Botanicals (9 total)

- Juniper (33%)
- Coriander (21%)
- Angelica Root (11%)
- Orris Root (5%)
- Cranberries from Cape Cod
- 4 other botanicals (can't give away all our secrets)

#### Water


- From the Quabbin Reservoir
- Rated best tasting water in the country
- Reverse osmosis and carbon filtered to remove chloramines and fluoride (we don't think they add to the taste)

#### Base Material

- 100% Corn. (No wheat is used!)
