TASTE

Amandine is our modern take on traditional almond liqueur. Made with 100% California sweet almonds and rested in toasted American oak barrels, it is flavorful, yet ethereally light. The initial soft vanilla and caramel flavors coat the palate before the subtle sweetness of the spirit finishes with savory notes of warm brown butter.

BACKGROUND

Named after the culinary term for almonds, Amandine is refreshingly different from its artificial competitors. The cordial offers a pleasant balance of natural almond flavor with no syrupy aftertaste, and blends perfectly with smokey whiskeys, Reposados and dark rums. Brighten your favorite cocktail or cup of coffee with Amandine or enjoy it alone as a digestif.

PROCESS

We start by macerating neutral spirit on almonds for over two weeks before distilling. Distillation takes place in our 50 gallon Adolf Adrian pot still. We age the spirit in new toasted oak barrels along with a few extra pounds of almonds to add that extra sublime flavor. We finally add a touch of sweetness using demerara sugar.

Base Material


- 100% Corn (No gluten)
